

#### "BELOVED, BROKEN AND BEAUTIFUL"

(Heb 10:1 The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming—not the realities themselves.)


# We see through a glass darkly now, but God will clear things up.







## The Jesus Lens

### God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.



#### A False Dichotomy



"Aren't you, like me, hoping that some person, thing, or event will come along to give you that final feeling of inner well-being you desire?

You know that this is the compulsiveness that keeps us going and busy, but at the same time makes us wonder whether we are getting anywhere in the long run.

This is the way to spiritual exhaustion and burn-out.

"Every time you feel hurt, offended, or rejected, you have to dare to say to yourself:

These feelings, strong as they may be, are not telling me the truth about myself.

The truth, even though I cannot feel it right now, is that I am the chosen child of God, precious in God's eyes, called the Beloved from all eternity, and held safe in an everlasting belief."

"It's such a powerful experience to be in the presence of someone who sees our brokenness —maybe because they live with us and it's obvious, or it's a therapist, or a friend, or at a recovery meeting — and who sees through the brokenness to the invincible preciousness of our self in the midst of our brokenness.
