



The shepherds received a message of joy!




John 15:9-11 (THE MESSAGE)

The Incarnation expresses the Trinity's redemptive determination to penetrate our fallen imaginations and get inside our blindness so that we can be healed and restored completely from the inside out.



Jesus came to reveal the true face of the Father and heal our blindness so we can see with His eyes and experience the love he continually enjoys in His Father's embrace.


"God loves you so utterly and completely that he has given himself for you in Jesus Christ his beloved Son, and has thereby pledged his very being as God for your salvation.

We've been on a remarkable journey of reimagining and rediscovering who Trinity is and always has been and who we are as God's beloved children.


- 1. What 'new thing' has Trinity helped you perceive and change your mind about in recent years about God, yourself, or others? What is He still working on changing?
